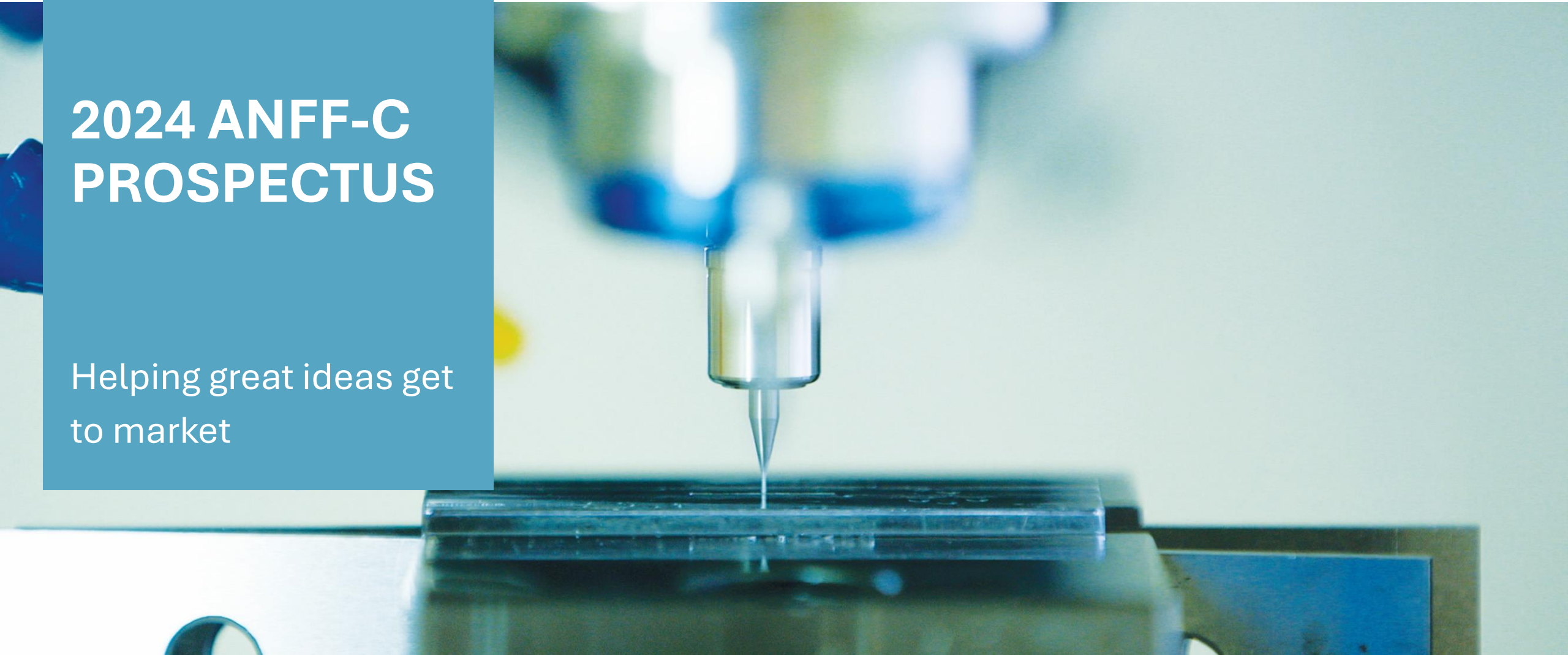

Overview

Our philosophy is to reduce the commercial risk associated with early-stage ventures to make them more attractive for professional investment rounds

We work with you on how best to utilise the funds.

ANFF-C is a non-dilutive pre-seed fund designed to support early-stage ventures that have developed products or devices using ANFF's technology platforms.

Features of ANFF-C Funding

Clarifying path to market while reducing commercial risk



Value

Funds to the value of \$120K are available. Generally, this is split into a Gate 1 (\$20K) and a Gate 2 (\$100K) application. Under certain circumstances, this can be combined into one application.

- Rapid turnaround
- Non-diluting
- Co-promotion
- Confidentiality

Funds

The funds may be used in a variety of ways. ANFF works with you to maximise the benefit of the funding.

Process

The money is used to pay 3rd party service providers. We do not give the money directly to the applicant.



Potential Uses for ANFF-C Funding



Gate 1

The \$20K (Gate 1) funding tends to be used for business validation.

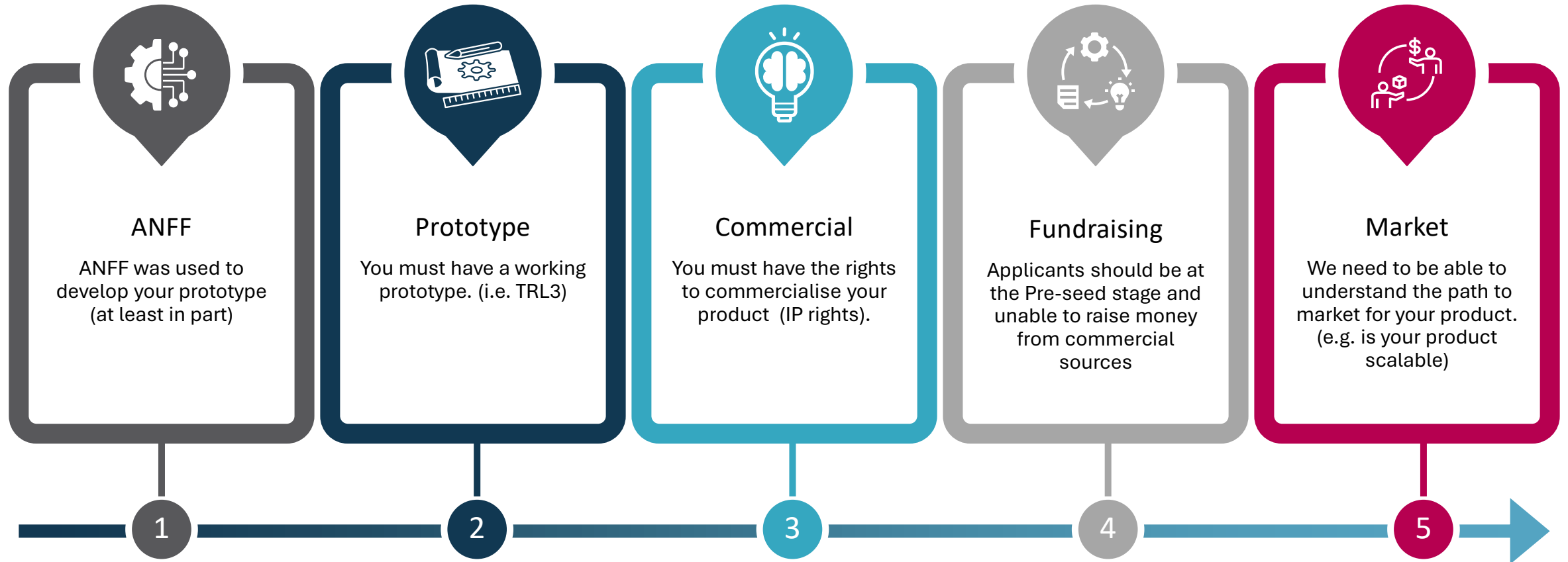
- Market research
- Business cases
- Patent landscape reviews
- Financial modelling

Gate 2

The \$100K (Gate 2) funding tends to be used for strategic applications.

- Manufacturing strategies
- Quality assurance
- Regulatory
- Pre-clinical studies
- IM development

Eligibility considerations

Access to ANFF

We cannot fund access to ANFF facilities/tools.



Staff Salaries

We do not support staff salaries. Funding is used to pay third party service providers.



Research

Funds may not be used to support research activities.



Intellectual Property

ANFF-C funds cannot be used to pay for IP filing costs. The funds may be used for IP strategies or landscape reviews.

The ANFF-C Process



The first step is to reach out to ANFF-C. We will conduct an interview to assess your eligibility and begin the budget conversation.

Agree on how to best utilise ANFF-C funding and collect quotes from recognised suppliers.

Complete the ANFF-C application forms and submit for review. NB Our forms are only available after the ANFF-C team have completed the interview step.

The Gate 1 application is reviewed internally. The Gate 2 application review is more in depth, utilising both ANFF board members and external subject-matter experts.
Review Times:
Gate 1 ~ a week
Gate 2 - 4-6 weeks

We formalise the funding terms with a Funding Letter. NB The ANFF funds are used to pay third party providers and it is not given to your company.
